USE 1 PART
PRE MIX TO
20 PARTS PROMIX**

**ALL VALUES ARE PER GALLON
PH WATER to 7.0 BEFORE ADDING BIO BIZZ**

rooted cuttings - 18 or 24 hours of light

Root Juice

Do Not Use "Root Juice" until roots appear

Week 1 8ml

Use blue light during veg stage and first 2 weeks of flower to improve internodal spacing & to reduce stretching

vegetive stage - 18 hours of light

Root Juice Fish Mix

week 1 8ml 4ml

week 2 8ml 8ml

week 3 8ml 8ml

If Yellowing occurs,
Foliar Spray 12ml Fish Mix / gallon once per week for vegetive stage.
Do NOT Foliar spray when high powered lights are on.

Transition to flower: (hardest time of a plants life)

All transplanting should be done. Make sure daytime temp is around 80°.

Very important that nighttime temperatures stay above 70°, this will improve your internodal spacing & reduce stretching.

First week of flower keep your lights at least 24" above plants

flowering stage - 12 hours of light

Bio Grow Bio Bloom Fish Mix Alg-A-Mic Top Max

week 1 4ml 8ml 4ml 4ml

week 2 4ml 8ml 4ml 4ml

week 3 8ml 8ml 8ml 4ml

week 4 8ml 8ml 8ml 4ml

week 5 12ml 12ml 12ml 4ml

week 6 12ml 12ml 12ml 16ml

week 7 16ml 16ml 16ml 16ml

week 8 16ml 16ml 16ml 16ml

Foliar Spray

8ml / gallon Alg-A-Mic & Water
Once per week for entire flowering stage.

Do NOT spray when high powered lights are on.

If going 7 weeks of flower (with food) skip week 4

Ripening stage:

Use fresh water & Top Max only for minimum 7 days

Lowering temperature in dark cycle during last week will promote higher crystal & resin production.

If your plants become stressed at any stage:

Some stresses can be caused from: lights being too close / over fertilization / insect infestation / temperature fluxuation

Raise the lights to 24" , water plants with fresh water for 3 waterings,

when plants show signs of growth again, continue with regular feeding program.

Ensure that your plants dry out between waterings.
